All 420 texts, both fiction and non-fiction, have been developed using carefully graded vocabulary lists, e.g. the word 'go' is introduced at Level 1 and 'going' is introduced at Level 4. Therefore, children build up a bank of high-frequency words, providing them with a smoother transition as they are introduced to higher-level texts. The texts enable children to build on their prior knowledge and make new connections based on these previous understandings.
